Barriers will be placed out 10x5m around each table. (minimum)

Fixed times and table numbers to all matches will be printed in the tournament program.

All matches will be played as best of five games.

Please note that the SOCC tournament can only take maximum 32 teams in each team category and maximum 72 players in each individual category. The results of SOCC will count for the ITTF-ranking.

### **Limitations:**

Players (taking part in SOCC-events) are also allowed to participate in one event on Saturday and one event on Sunday in the Ängby international.

Players (**NOT TAKING PART IN SOCC**) are also allowed to participate in one event on Friday, two events on Saturday and one event on Sunday in the Ängby international.

In Men's Singles the maximum number of entrances in the qualification round is 96 players and 16 players will be directly qualified to Saturday's final knock-out stage.

In Women's Singles the maximum number of entrances in the qualification round is 64 players and 16 players will be directly qualified to Saturday's final knock-out stage.

The final knock-out rounds in both Men's Singles and women's single will be played on Saturday.

#### **Entries:**

Players date of birth has to be given in the entry form. Players shall be listed in order of playing level.

The organizing club has the right to enter four "wild card" players in each event in Ängby international.

Girls are not allowed to participate in the boys' events.

#### **Seeding:**

Seeding will be set up by the World, European and Swedish rankings and in cooperation with the Swedish Table Tennis Association.

### **Draw:**

The draws for knock-out events will be made in the Ängby office on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> November. The draws for the group events will be made after check-in at the playing venue (one hour before start) on the day of competition.
