- C-Class Mixed class. Here men's play from deep as well as league and district women's circle from men's seasons league of women from district league seasons and deeper.

Youth U18	Open to all girls and boys born 01.01.1993 or later.
Youth U15	Open to all girls and boys born 01.01.1996 or later.
Youth U13	Open to all girls and boys born 01.01.1998 or later.
Youth U11	Open to all girls and boys born 01.01.2000 or later.

Teams of 2                      Open for all girls and boys of the appropriate age groups.  
In the women's and men's are open classes (Class A).

Beginner                      Open for girls and boys have the authorized volumes so far participated only at the district level in the championships, rankings and team games.

Elite                              Open to all girls and boys of authorized volumes.

Youth who may have a release for the adult teams will participate in each division, which applies to their team. Last year's winners of the B- and C-class must start in the next higher class.

### **VICTORY AWARDS**

In the individual competitions of the A-Class participants receive the semi-chash prizes. In other singles semi-final competitions, the participants trophies, medals and certificates. In all double and teams of 2 competitions, the final participant in kind of our vouchers supplier. These can be redeemed immediately at ist stall in the hall area.

## **GENERAL TOURNAMENTS**

1. It is played at 20 tables, with white three-star balls, according to rules of the ITTF, text and supplementary provisions of the DTTB and TTVSH.
2. All individual competitions are played in groups. The first two of a group qualify for the main round determines the winner in the single knockout system. In the youth sector, the other group members qualify for the consolation round.
3. The respective double-competitions are held in simple KO-system.
4. All teams of 2 competitions are held in groups of 3 in the following order: (Single-1, Single-2, Mixed or Doubles). The game ends with the 2nd-point victory. The first two of a group where the winners will qualify in simple KO-system are determined for the main round.
5. Have joined the teams of 2 more than 16 teams will be played in single elimination system.
6. All competitions are more than three sets to the eleventh point and played until the winning point. The third place is not played.
7. The message required to pay the entry fee. Lack of participants can be replaced with equally strong participants.
8. Participants count their own games. The first player called up, or get the first-called dual or team pick up the ball and the SR-form in the tournament management. The winner or bring the ball back and the completed SR-paper to show direction. The finals are set by the organizing club referee. Each participant is required at the request of tournament management to include one or more games.
9. Participants who are not taken after three calls to be dropped from the competition.
10. Changes that are necessary to the smooth flow of the tournament are reserved by the Tournament Director.
11. Each participant is allowed to start on one day only once in the morning and once in the afternoon.
12. With less than six participants, classes will be grouped together.
13. Participation in the tournament is only permitted in sport just clothes.
14. The instructions of the Tournament Committee and the OSR is to be obeyed.
15. For drinks and snacks makes the host.
16. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost or misplaced things.
17. Smoking is prohibited on the school premises.
18. Taking pictures with flash in the hall, during the competitions.
19. Case of a tie in the group system decides the larger difference between the won and lost games. Is this the same, decide the difference between won and lost records. Is this also the same, decide the direct comparison.
20. Or emergency medical service can be requested by the Tournament Committee.

22. The tournament has been approved by TTVSH.
23. The draw will take place at the tournament, ahead of the competition, instead of by computer in the Tournament Director.
24. The tents on the school grounds is prohibited.
25. Our tournament is attended by players and players from all over Germany, the Baltic region, particularly from Scandinavia, but also from Estonia and Poland and other European countries. The skill level ranges from the lowest administrative class to the top international level.
